13 Construction of 3P air rifle frames

For standing we use the normal airgun catchers. For prone and kneeling Contact Keith. The design agreed upon was as follows:- Three pellet catchers, for three airgun firing points. The same catcher to be used for prone and kneeling. A cross section through the catcher is a right angled triangle. The vertical holds the target, perhaps made from plywood. The horizontal is similarly made from plywood and collects the pellets. The hypoteneuse is made from light steel and deflects the pellet, onto the horizontal plywood, taking the power out of it.
